1. Privacy notice for the Juvenile Swimming Lesson Programme – Active Ennis

3. Legal basis for the processing of personal data as part of the Juvenile Swimming Lesson programme

The legal basis for the personal data processing under GDPR is provided by articles 6(1) (a), (b) and (d).

6 (1) (a) the data subject (through their parent/guardian) has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes; The data subject has the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

6 (1) (b) processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party;

6 (1) (d) processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person;

As the lesson programme is provided by a third-party service provider (Brendan McGrath) for Clare County Council, relevant data about the participant (name, age, medical condition) will be shared with the service provider to enable the lessons to be managed and to protect the vital interest of the participants. The data provided will be used to ensure the programme participant is matched to the correct lesson programme.

Personal data provided will be stored in hard and soft copy by Clare County Council. Hard copy files will be stored in locked cabinet and the soft copy information will be password protected.

7. Records Retention Policy

Clare County Council will retain the record for 5 years (or as long as the child is a participant in the programme).

8. Your Rights
