Privacy Notice

1. Privacy notice for the Juvenile Swimming Lesson Programme – Active Ennis

The council also has a Privacy statement which is a general document about how we approach data protection as an Organisation and is available on the council's website <https://www.clarecoco.ie/info/privacy-statement/> or on request.

In order to administer and provide a safe and efficient juvenile swimming lesson programme and to protect the vital interests of the programme participants, Clare County Council are required to collect and process the personal data of participants in the programme. In the main the participants are minors and therefore the information including 'personal data' is being provided by the participants' parent/legal guardian.

This swimming programme is delivered by either Clare County Council Ennis Leisure staff directly, or a third-party service contractor for the Council and to this end personal data provided in the application form will be shared with the service provider to protect the vital interests of the participants.

2. Why do we have this privacy notice?

Clare County Council (Data Controller) has created this privacy statement in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to privacy and to assure you that in all your dealings with Clare County Council that we will ensure transparency and security of the personal data you provide to us.

3. Legal basis for the processing of personal data as part of the Juvenile Swimming Lesson programme

The legal basis for the personal data processing under GDPR is provided by articles 6(1) (a), (b) and (d).

6 (1) (a) the data subject (through their parent/guardian) has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes; The data subject has the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

6 (1) (b) processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party;

6 (1) (d) processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person;

Because special category data (medical condition) may be involved in the case of some data subjects, legal basis is also provided for under Article 9 (2) (a), the

data subject (through their parent/guardian) has given explicit consent to the processing for a specified purpose.

4. Purpose of the processing

The personal data is being processed in order to run the swimming lesson programme safely and to provide for an effective response to be delivered in the event of an emergency for the participant.

5. Types of Personal data required

In advance of completing the application form for participation in the Juvenile Swimming Lesson programme you should read this privacy statement and the application form taking care to answer all of the questions fully where these are relevant to you. Failing to provide the data and fully complete and sign the form will render your application void.

Applicants are required to provide information on the following categories of personal data

- Personal details (name, address, phone number) of participant and parent/guardian
- Additional name and contact number in case of emergency
- Relationship of emergency contact to the applicant
- Age of participant
- Medical condition of participant relevant to participation in the swim programme
- Swimming competence

6. Recipients of the personal data - How your personal data will be used/processed by Active Ennis

As the lesson programme is provided by either a third-party service provider (Brendan McGrath) for Clare County Council or by Clare County Council directly, relevant data about the participant (name, age, medical condition) will be shared with the service provider or swim teacher to enable the lessons to be managed and to protect the vital interest of the participants. The data provided will be used to ensure the participant is matched to the correct lesson programme. Personal data provided will be stored in hard and soft copy by Clare County Council. Hard copy files will be stored in locked cabinet and the soft copy information will be password protected.

7. Records Retention Policy

Clare County Council will retain the record for 5 years (or as long as the child is a participant in the programme).

8. Your Rights

Data subjects have privacy rights: the right to request access to an rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning the data

subject or to object to processing as well as the right to data portability. The Council has a policy and procedure for the exercise of these rights.

9. Right of Compliant to the Office of the Data Protection Commission

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of the response you received from Clare County Council in relation to your data rights or if you have complaint to make about your data handling, then you are entitled to make a complaint to the Data Protection Commission who may investigate the matter for you.
